HEAP

Heap has been designed with outdoor and non-traditional presentation spaces in mind. These

specifications are indicative only. Schedule

Pre-Show Call – One hour prior to performance with

venue access to dressing rooms.

Show - Up to 3 x 20 minute roving performances

over a 3-hour period.

Post-Show Call – One half hour post performance

for cool down and reset.

People 1 puppeteer, 1 performer/minder

Presenter & Venue Requirements We require up to date site plans that detail any

performance or roving entertainment zones, green room location, dressing room location and

amenities.

For engagements inside Tasmania, Heap travels in a single 1.8 tonne high roof, long wheelbase van, or 3 tonne Pantech. Heap requires on-site parking.

For seasons outside of Tasmania presenter will be required to organise freight to and from venue. Heap

travels in a road case measuring

Performance Area The performance area must have a ceiling higher

than 4 metres and be relatively flat. It can be

indoors or outdoors.

Dressing Rooms, Wardrobe & Green Room

Requirements

Adequate dressing room facilities sufficient for 2 people. Dressing rooms should be secure and lockable with general power outlets available and access to toilets and shower backstage.

1 x clothing rack with coat hangers for costumes

and 1 full length mirror.

Dressing room should have ability to suspend a single hanging point for puppet storage. Where not available Terrapin may be able to supply a pop-up marquee for puppet storage. Facilities must be no more than a 5-minute walk from performance space

or start of roving route.



TIP DUCK

Designed with outdoor and non-traditional presentation spaces in mind. It is a hit with audiences of all ages as an incidental activation of a large outdoor space, a greeter in foyers or a roving puppet. These specifications are indicative only.

. Schedule

Pre-Show Call – One hour prior to performance with venue access to dressing rooms.

Show - Up to **3 x 20 minute** roving performances over a 3-hour period.

Post-Show Call – One half hour post performance for cool down and reset.

1 puppeteer, 1 performer/minder

Presenter & Venue Requirements

We require up to date site plans that detail any performance or roving entertainment zones, green room location, dressing room location and amenities.

For engagements inside Tasmania, Tip Duck travels in a single 1.8 tonne high roof, long wheelbase van, or 3 tonne Pantech. Tip-Duck requires on-site parking.

For seasons outside of Tasmania presenter will be required to organise freight to and from venue. Tip Duck travels in a road case measuring approx. 1300x1210x800mm.

Performance Area

The performance area must have a ceiling higher than 4 metres and be relatively flat. It can be indoors or outdoors.

Dressing Rooms, Wardrobe & Green Room Requirements

Adequate dressing room facilities sufficient for 2 people. Dressing rooms should be secure and lockable with general power outlets available and access to toilets and shower backstage.

1 x clothing rack with coat hangers for costumes and 1 full length mirror.

Dressing room should have ability to suspend a single hanging point for puppet storage. Where not available Terrapin may be able to supply a pop-up marquee for puppet storage. Facilities must be no more than a 5-minute walk from performance space or start of roving route.
